IMPORTANT NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS REGARDING HB 735 SIGNED INTO LAW JUNE 30, 2021 HB1383 AMENDS HB735 – HB1383 SIGNED INTO LAW JUNE 20, 2023

Updated June 20, 2023

House Bill 735, The Pre-emption of Local Occupational Licensing, was signed into law by the State of Florida in June 2021. HB 735 was due to eliminate local construction licensing in certain specialty trades effective July 1, 2023.

In May 2023, the State of Florida passed HB 1383 amending the impacts of HB 735. HB 1383 was signed by the Governor on June 20, 2023.

HB 1383 extends the effective date of HB 735 from July 1, 2023 to July 1, 2024.

Effective immediately, ALL specialty licenses continue until July 1, 2024.

The legislation requires DBPR to create new state specialty license classifications. **This will positively impact locally licensed specialty contractors and allow those licenses to continue**. See section B below.

We have been actively engaged in discussions with State legislators. Our goal is to keep contractors working in Pinellas County. **Watch this space for updates.**

<u>HB 1383 Impact – The following license classifications will be eliminated effective July 1, 2024.</u>
There may be additional impacts on those contractors required to pull building permits under the Florida Building Code.

All specialty contractors MUST complete 14 continuing education units and renew their license by September 30, 2023. License fees have been reduced. License renewals will expire June 30, 2024 unless extended by law.
