PUBLIC HEARINGS:

- E. ADMINISTER OATH (all individuals wishing to present testimony): Informal Hearings: Mr. Holderith
 - Paul Incorvaia / C-9505 Marine Specialty Contractor for EP23-10245
 (Complainant St. Pete Beach) PCCLB heard this case on November 13, 2023. The fine remains unpaid and the permit has not been reinstated or a final inspection completed. The Board gave Mr. Incorvaia until March 11, 2024, to reinstate and resolve the permit and fine. Mr. Incorvaia has indicated to PCCLB that he wishes to appeal the decision of the building official. The contractor has been provided with the information necessary to initiate the appeal.
 - Bruce Kobel Requests a hearing before the PCCLB regarding citations he received for contracting without a license: 24-0057/24-0058. Evidence packet to be presented by PCCLB Investigator J. Padgett.

3. Jeffrey Munger – I-CAC1817386 / Requests a hearing before the PCCLB via Election of Rights for expire permit violations: 20-10665 and 20-11449. Mr. Munger believes his office communicated these were abandoned due to a staff member pulling the permit for an incorrect address.

F. Revocation of License: Ms. Krickovic

- CORRECTION: it was reported at the January 8, 2024 meeting that state certified contractor Gary Seligman, I-CRC1327728, was deceased and his license was closed. Mr. Seligman's license was Revoked by DBPR on November 3, 2023 and revoked by this Board at the meeting. Mr. Seligman's license was revoked but he is not deceased. We apologize for the error.
- 2. Matthew Schoeppe I-CBC1256495 / Contractor was deceased on January 11, 2023 and license was closed with PCCLB on or about January 30, 2024. A copy of the contractor's death certificate was submitted to us as evidence. Mr. Schoeppe's license continues to show active with DBPR as of March 11, 2024. This has been reported to DBPR.
- 3. David Traynham C-9912 / Contractor was deceased on September 10, 2020 and license was closed with PCCLB on or about February 9, 2024. Case Number 2019-682 for an Administrative Fine of \$300 had remained unpaid and has been reduced to \$0.00 as uncollectible.

 This committee will review the current Board Rules to ensure compliance with newly
 adopted legislation and make recommendations to the Board. It is the
 recommendation of management that this committee be comprised of two contractor
 members, one or two building official members and one citizen representative from
 the Board.
- 3. Case Review Committee: Ms. Krickovic

The Case Review Committee determines whether sufficient evidence exists to support an Administrative Complaint for violation of rules and statutes governing licensed contractors. Under Rule 11.04(b) adopted May 17, 2021, the Committee includes the Director, the Code Enforcement Division Manager as senior PCCLB investigator, a contractor member of the Board, and, if the subject matter of the case includes a major violation of the Florida Building Code, a city or county Building Official. Two volunteers are being sought: a contractor member of the Board and a Building Official. Meetings are anticipated to be held every 60 days between Board meetings.
