License Types	Continuing Education Requirements
Air Conditioning Contractor – Class A, B	14 hours of CE – minimum of 1 hour specialized or advanced module, 1 hour workplace safety, 1 hour business practices, 1 hour workers' compensation, 1 hour laws and rules, and the remaining hours can be any board approved construction related instruction.
Building Contractor	14 hours of CE – minimum of 1 hour specialized or advanced module, 1 hour workplace safety, 1 hour business practices, 1 hour workers' compensation, 1 hour laws and rules, 1 hour of wind mitigation, and the remaining hours can be any board approved construction related instruction.
General Contractor	14 hours of CE – minimum of 1 hour specialized or advanced module, 1 hour workplace safety, 1 hour business practices, 1 hour workers' compensation, 1 hour laws and rules, 1 hour of wind mitigation, and the remaining hours can be any board approved construction related instruction.
Mechanical Contractor	14 hours of CE – minimum of 1 hour specialized or advanced module, 1 hour workplace safety, 1 hour business practices, 1 hour workers' compensation, 1 hour laws and rules, and the remaining hours can be any board approved construction related instruction.
Plumbing Contractor	14 hours of CE – minimum of 1 hour specialized or advanced module, 1 hour workplace safety, 1 hour business practices, 1 hour workers' compensation, 1 hour laws and rules, and the remaining hours can be any board approved construction related instruction.
Pool/Spa Contractor – Commercial, Residential and Servicing; Residential Pool/Spa Servicing Specialty	14 hours of CE – minimum of 1 hour specialized or advanced module, 1 hour workplace safety, 1 hour business practices, 1 hour workers' compensation, 1 hour laws and rules, 1 hour of pool electrical requirements*, and the remaining hours can be any board approved construction related instruction. *effective beginning with 2019 renewal cycle for registered contractors

License Types	Continuing Education Requirements
Residential Contractor	14 hours of CE – minimum of 1 hour specialized or advanced module, 1 hour workplace safety, 1 hour business practices, 1 hour workers' compensation, 1 hour laws and rules, 1 hour of wind mitigation, and the remaining hours can be any board approved construction related instruction.
Roofing Contractor	14 hours of CE – minimum of 1 hour specialized or advanced module, 1 hour workplace safety, 1 hour business practices, 1 hour workers' compensation, 1 hour laws and rules, 1 hour of wind mitigation, and the remaining hours can be any board approved construction related instruction.
Specialty Contractors – Glass & Glazing; Specialty Structure; Structural Masonry; Structural Steel Work; Shutter/Opening Protectives; Garage Door; Carpentry Specialty	14 hours of CE – minimum of 1 hour specialized or advanced module, 1 hour workplace safety, 1 hour business practices, 1 hour workers' compensation, 1 hour laws and rules, 1 hour of wind mitigation, and the remaining hours can be any board approved construction related instruction.
Specialty Contractors – Demolition; Drywall; Natural Gas Specialty; Irrigation; Marine; Plaster and Lath	14 hours of CE – minimum of 1 hour specialized or advanced module, 1 hour workplace safety, 1 hour business practices, 1 hour workers' compensation, 1 hour laws and rules, and the remaining hours can be any board approved construction related instruction.
Underground Utility & Excavation Contractor	14 hours of CE – minimum of 1 hour specialized or advanced module, 1 hour workplace safety, 1 hour business practices, 1 hour workers' compensation, 1 hour laws and rules, and the remaining hours can be any board approved construction related instruction.
Specialty Contractors – Fence Erection Specialty, Veneer Specialty	14 hours of CE – minimum of 1 hour specialized or advanced module, 1 hour workplace safety, 1 hour business practices, 1 hour workers' compensation, 1 hour laws and rules, 1 hour of wind mitigation, and the remaining hours can be any board approved construction related instruction.

Continuing education requirements align with the corresponding or substantially similar state licenses. The Fence Erection Specialty Contractor and Veneer Specialty Contractor licenses remain compliant with Section 489.117(4)(a)3., Florida Statutes (2024), reaffirmed by the PCCLB March 11, 2024.

Alarm System Contractor I	 7 hours of Continuing Education must include: 1 hour workers' compensation 1 hour workplace safety 1 hour business practices 1 hour Florida Laws & Rules 2 hours false alarm prevention 1 hour Florida Building Code advanced module course + 7 hours can be any board approved construction related instruction (Total 14 hours)
Alarm System Contractor II	 7 hours of Continuing Education must include: 1 hour workers' compensation 1 hour workplace safety 1 hour business practices 1 hour Florida Laws & Rules 2 hours false alarm prevention 1 hour Florida Building Code advanced module course + 7 hours can be any board approved construction related instruction (Total 14 hours)
Specialty Electrical Contractor	 7 hours of Continuing Education must include: 1 hour workers' compensation 1 hour workplace safety 1 hour business practices 1 hour Florida Laws & Rules 1 hour Florida Building Code advanced module course 1 hour of Technical 1 hour general credit + 7 hours can be any board approved construction related instruction (Total 14 hours)
