

## CONTRACTOR CLASSIFICATIONS

## Updated May 23, 2024

If you want to become licensed in any of the following trades, we recommend that you <u>apply directly to</u> <u>the Construction Industry Licensing Board or the Electrical Contractors' Licensing Board.</u>

Becoming state licensed will allow you to work anywhere in the state of Florida as a state certified contractor or state certified specialty contractor. Your state license is recognized in Pinellas County.

New applicants with out-of-state experience are strongly encouraged to apply to the state.

Pinellas County offers local licenses in the following contractor trades. Upon receiving your local license in any of these classifications, you must register your PCCLB license with the state. The process to register is almost identical to the application process for state certification (except you take the PCCLB-designated exams instead of the state-issued exams).

Pinellas County requires specialty licenses in the following contractor trades. If you intend to work outside of Pinellas County in addition to your local work here, we recommend that you **apply directly to the Construction Industry Licensing Board and become state certified.** 

If you are licensed in an identical or similar specialty trade in another jurisdiction in the state of Florida, we may recognize your specialty license and you may become licensed by reciprocity. If you are not licensed

or your specialty license from another jurisdiction is not deemed equivalent, you will need to be licensed by examination.
